Photographic Competition

- Entries will be accepted from members of the Heraldry Society of Scotland but must be the individuals own work
- A maximum of three photographs on an Heraldic subject, each mounted on stiff black A5 card, can be submitted by each entrant
- No legends, titles etc. should be attached to the front of the entry
- The following information should be attached to the **reverse** of the card:
 - The title of the photograph
 - The name and address of the entrant
 - The location where the photograph was taken
- No enhancements, other than normal “darkroom” practice should be made to the entry
- All submissions will remain the property of the entrant, however by entering the competition the individual agrees to the future publication of the entry in TakTent at the discretion of the Editor.
- Receipt of entries will acknowledged by email
- The closing date for entries is 31st August
- Entries can only be returned if accompanied by a stamped self-address envelope
- The winner will receive a complimentary ticket to attend the St Andrew Dinner at which the presentation of a certificate will be made
- The runner(s) up will receive a certificate
